 The group has operations in 54 countries serving a diverse group of clients that is supported by approximately 34,000 people worldwide.
- Going forward, CHUBB will be expanding into the Hong Kong markets after collaborating with Hang Seng Bank in a 15-year deal to provide coverage options for individuals and businesses in Hong Kong. CHUBB will also be establishing an aviation hub in Singapore as part of their strategic regional focus for the Chubb Global Markets (CGM) aviation team.
- Insurance industry may able to weather the challenging economic outlook, driven by rising wages as well as rising concerns about health and mortality risks, especially post Covid-19 pandemic. Based on Bloomberg consensus estimates, CHUBB has a 78.6% Buy rating with an average 12-month target price of USD234.75 (potential 17.5% upside from current share price) from 28 research houses.

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Technical Outlook

 Technically, price has turned downbeat at the start of the year before forming a double bottom formation. With price finding stability, price has since recovered to close above both SMA20 and SMA50 in recent days. This implies that price is on the bottoming out formation and ripe for a recovery. With price forming a breakout above USD195.04 to target the next resistances at USD203.61-205.87 with long term target set at USD213.99. Support is pegged at USD186.61 and cut loss is located at USD185.00.
